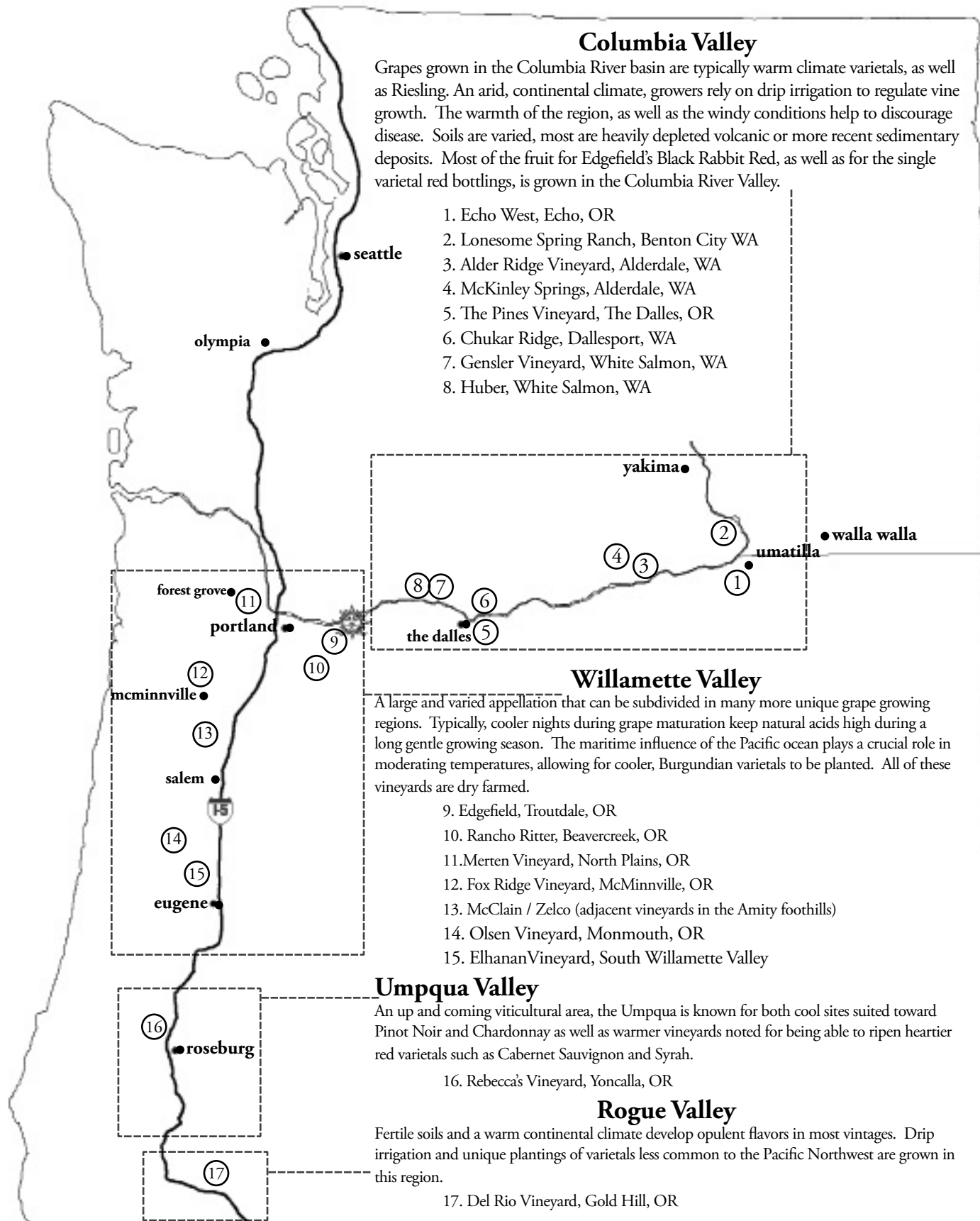


Edgefield Winery's Vineyard Map

Columbia Valley

Grapes grown in the Columbia River basin are typically warm climate varieties, as well as Riesling. An arid, continental climate, growers rely on drip irrigation to regulate vine growth. The warmth of the region, as well as the windy conditions help to discourage disease. Soils are varied, most are heavily depleted volcanic or more recent sedimentary deposits. Most of the fruit for Edgefield's Black Rabbit Red, as well as for the single varietal red bottlings, is grown in the Columbia River Valley.

Willamette Valley

A large and varied appellation that can be subdivided in many more unique grape growing regions. Typically, cooler nights during grape maturation keep natural acids high during a long gentle growing season. The maritime influence of the Pacific ocean plays a crucial role in moderating temperatures, allowing for cooler, Burgundian varieties to be planted. All of these vineyards are dry farmed.

Umpqua Valley

An up and coming viticultural area, the Umpqua is known for both cool sites suited toward Pinot Noir and Chardonnay as well as warmer vineyards noted for being able to ripen heartier red varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah.

Rogue Valley

Fertile soils and a warm continental climate develop opulent flavors in most vintages. Drip irrigation and unique plantings of varieties less common to the Pacific Northwest are grown in this region.
