Named for Edgefield's fabled mascot, the 2007 Black Rabbit Red is a smooth and spicy blend composed of classic Bordeaux varietals with a Pacific Northwest twist. Garnet in color with baking spice aromas of cinnamon and nutmeg, fruit flavors of black cherry and blackcurrant and a hint of white pepper, this medium tannin wine has a lengthy, smooth finish.

Fun Facts: All of the grapes that make up the Black Rabbit are harvested separately, and then fermented and aged separately in oak barrels. The tasting process begins several months before bottling where the winemaking staff starts to taste and blend the wines together. It isn't until the most balanced blend is achieved before it goes into the bottle. Each vintage brings a new blend. ENJOY!
