**Tasting Notes:** The 2007 Syrah is a big, bold wine, with aromas of dark cherry, fig, plum, licorice and barrel spice. An exceptional syrah with balanced acidity and low tannin this wine is drinking nicely now and will continue to please for years to come.

**Food Pairing:** Foods that best compliment our 2006 Syrah are hearty winter dishes like stew, casseroles, steaks, burgers, and game. For something on the sweet side try dark chocolate, it will enhance the wines fruit flavors.

**Fun Facts:** Syrah has many synonyms that are used in various parts of the world including Antourenein Noir, Balsamina, Candive, Entournerein, Hignin Noir, Marsanne Noir, Schiras, Sirac, Syra, Syrac, Serine, Sereine, and of course Shiraz. Syrah originated as an offspring of two obscure French varieties, Dureza and Mondeuse Blanche, which is not to be confused with Petite Syrah which is a synonym for a different grape called Durif.
